Annual Unit Hearing Test: Please call 526-6976 to schedule a group of 16 or more.

Annual Hearing Health Education Brief: Each Unit at the *Company* level will receive an annual briefing to increase awareness of noise-induced hearing loss and hearing protection IAW DA Pam 40-501. Please submit form to schedule.

Hearing Program Officer (HPO) Certification Course: Each Unit at the *Company* level is required to have an appointed (on orders) HPO. Please enroll committed soldiers (E-5 and above) who are able to instruct, educate, and enforce Hearing Program guidelines IAW DA Pam 40-501 and all outlining guidelines from the OTSG. Soldiers must have 24 - 36 months left time on station.

Earplug Fitting Course: Designed to train unit representatives on the appropriate use, care, selection and fitting of hearing protection devices.

Group/ Unit Earplug Fittings: Please schedule groups larger than 16 by calling (719) 526-6976. It is the responsibility of the unit to purchase hearing protection per DA-PAM 40-501.

Hearing Conservation Technician Certification Course: This course is designed for DOD military personnel or DOD civilians, who have Hearing Program duties assigned, specifically the use of the Defense Occupational and Environmental Readiness System - Hearing Conservation (DOEHRs-HC) as part of their work responsibilities.
