

## OB Ultrasound

This exam is to inform your doctor of such things as fetal age, position and placement location. The ultrasound technologists are not allowed to release any medical information to patients.

Ultrasounds are not 100% accurate for determining your baby's sex.

Depending on how the baby is laying, the amount of fluid in your bladder, the baby's age and other factors, it may or may not be possible to determine your baby's sex. If you wish to be told your baby's sex, you will be asked to read and sign a release to show you understand this is not always accurate.

Expectant mothers will receive their screening ultrasound between 18-20 weeks gestation.

Your provider will order your ultrasound. OB ultrasound screenings are performed in the Radiology Department.
