

Clinics open during severe weather

Winter in Colorado means snow. And with that snow the streets of Colorado Springs and Fort Carson can become a dangerous slip and slide.

For these severe weather days the Fort Carson command will issue weather advisories – early release, two hour delay or post closure. Regardless of what the post announces Evans' clinics will remain open for patients who have appointments. Other than the Emergency Department, walk-ins will not be accepted.

On the days that Fort Carson issues an early release announcement, the hospital clinics will see patients currently waiting and attempt to contact those who have appointments later in the day in order to reschedule them. If those patients want to keep that day's appointments they will be seen, at the scheduled time or sooner if possible.

If Fort Carson announces a two hour reporting delay or post closure our clinics will open on time. If patients are not able to make their appointments on these days, they will not be considered "no-shows". On post closure days, clinic staff members will attempt to contact patients to reschedule appointments.

On two-hour delay days the Patient Access Services (appointment line) will not book appointments prior to 9:30 a.m. No new appointments will be made for days when the post has closed due to severe weather.

If a patient does not want to venture out to make their appointment on these days, they should call the appointment line at 526-CARE (2273) to cancel and reschedule their visits for the earliest.

Patients who book their appointments or their dependent minors' appointments through TRICARE Online can cancel online anytime.
