- Located at 1650 Cochrane Circle (Rm 1200, Soldier Family Care Center)
- Who can be seen?
 - Dependents with TRICARE Prime
 - Active Duty Military (Marital Therapy Only)
- Provides easily accessible behavioral health counseling services to Children and Adolescents of Active Duty Service Members. Services include:
 - Individual Therapy;
 - Family Therapy;
 - Marital Therapy;
 - Psychological Testing; and
 - Psychiatry – Medication Management
- School Based Behavioral Health
 - Elementary School (Abrams, Mountainside, Patriot, and Weikel)
 - Middle School (Carson)
